
EMPOWERMENT CASE IN POLAND



- Tool developed by EMSP to compare the situation of MS patients in different countries.
- Repoland occupies one of the last places and the situation has not changed much since 2009


MS Barometer 2011

MS Barometer 2011 Overall results



- 33 countries






- № In overall results Poland occupies the 4th place from the bottom.
- BUT in Empowerment of PwMS
 Poland occupies the 14th place,
 position in the middle of the ranking

Poland's results

Empowerment of PwMS (max. score for this section: 35 points)

- □ Time limited DMD therapy 5 years
- Before 2012 − 3 year therapy limit
- + discriminative age criterion

The change occurred thanks to the innitiative of Polish MS Society.
BUT the therapy should not be time limited, it should last as long as it brings

Effective empowerment tool: Polish MS Parliamentary Group:

- 13 MPs
- different political background
- united by common interest improvement of the situation of PwMS
- 6 meetings organised together with Polish MS Society
- Letters, interpellations

Empowerment and Lobbying

A patient in diagnosed with MS in Poland has to face not only the disease but also the strict therapy regulations.

Empowerment case in Poland



- Multidisciplinary, multitask, (includes: rehabilitation, DMT, symptomatic treatment, national registry)

Empowerment and National Therapy Plan

- 500 new PwMS on DMDs/y
- Control: MRI after each year of treatment
- Possibility to change drug during the time of treatment (according to scheme –"code of good practice")
- Workshops and trainings for neurologists, nurses etc.

National Therapy Plan - DMT



- NTP − prepared by professionals and MS
 Society (both: content and budget) and
 submitted in 2005
- Now update of content is needed and is being done (as new treatments apeared)
